ADMISSION PROCEDURE

FOR TWO YEAR HIGHER SECONDARY COURSE (ARTS):

The Higher Secondary admission will be conducted through Darpan Portal as per the instruction of ASSEB.

FOR FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMME:

The office of the Principal shall issue notification through the college website for admission into FYUGP. Candidates having qualified in HSSLC/ Class 12th Examination are eligible to get admission into Four Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUGP). Application Forms and Prospectus of the college can be downloaded directly from the college website www.sapekhaticollege.co.in. The duly filled forms must be submitted on the date fixed by the college authority. Admission in UG Programme will be held strictly on the basis of merit. A list of the provisionally selected candidates will be prepared by the admission committee after thorough scrutiny of the forms and documents. Sapekhati College adopts the State Govt's Reservation Policy in admission process. A few seats may be allotted in HS and UG level to the students having outstanding performance in the field of Sports and Culture. There is provision for reservation of seats for differently abled person as per Government Rule. A few seats may be allotted for the sons/daughters of the employee of Sapekhati College in the academic programmes. Students who have passed the qualifying examination earlier than the current year must submit a gap certificate specifying the cause/ details of engagement during the period from the competent authority.

FOUR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (FYUGP) IN CBCS (ARTS)

Undergraduate programmes will include the following

- (i) UG Certificate Programme: UG Certificate programme leads to a UG certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study. Students on exit shall be awarded UG certificate (in the Field of Study/ Discipline) after securing the requisite 44 Credits on completion of Semester II if, in addition, they complete one work based/ skill based vocational course/ internship of 4 Credits within one year from the completion of 2nd semester examination. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within a period of three years and complete the degree within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.
- (ii) UG Diploma Programme: UG Diploma Programme leads to a UG diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study in the chosen fields of study. Students on exit shall be awarded UG Diploma (in the Field of Study/ Discipline) after securing the requisite 88 Credits on completion of Semester IV if, in addition, they complete one work based/ skill based vocational course/internship of 4 credits within one year from the completion of 4th semester examination. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within a period of three years and complete the degree within the maximum period of seven years.
- (iii) Three Year UG Degree Programme (BA, B.Sc, B.Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/ double major: Students who wish to undergo a 3- year (6 semester) UG Programme shall be awarded UG degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing a minimum of 132 credits. Provision of double Major shall be implemented in due course of time.
- (iv) Four Year UG Programme with honours (BA, B.Sc, B.Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/ double Major: Students who wish to undergo a 4- year (8 semester) UG Programme shall be awarded UG Honours degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of four years, securing a minimum of 176 credits. Provision of double Major shall be implemented in due course of time.
- (v) Four Year UG Programme with honours with Research (BA, B.Sc, B.Com and Bachelors in other disciplines) with single/ double Major: Students who wish to undergo a 4- year (8 semester) UG

Programme shall be awarded UG Honours and research degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of four years with a rigorous research project, securing a minimum of 176 credits. Provision of double Major shall be implemented in due course of time.

EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION:

1. Examination and evaluation shall be done on a continuous basis, at least two times during a Semester including the End Semester Examination.
2. There shall be 20% marks for in-semester assessment and 80% marks for End-Semester Examination in each course during every semester.
3. The 20% marks allotted for In-Semester Assessment in each course shall be based on the following:
 - (a) One Internal Examination (Sessional Examination): 50% of the marks allotted for In-Semester Assessment.
 - (b) Others (any one or more)- Seminar Presentation/ Assignment/ Group Discussion/ Quiz/ Viva-Voce: 50% of the marks allotted for In-Semester Assessment.

SEMESTER DURATION:

- (i) Odd Semesters: July—December (including end-semester examinations and semester breaks)
- (ii) Even Semester: January—June (including end-semester examinations and semester breaks)

IDENTITY CARD AND BADGE:

An Identity Card and a Badge will be issued to each student by the college at the time of admission. In the event of loss or damage of card or badge, a duplicate one will be issued from the office of the Principal on payment of Rs. 100.00 (one hundred) only for the same.

College uniform is mandatory for all the students and without uniform will not be allowed to enter in the college premises.

UNIFORM FOR BOYS: White Shirt and Black Pant with Black Shoes and Black Shocks.

UNIFORM FOR GIRLS: White Kurta- Pyjama and Pink coloured dupatta with Black shoes and white Shocks.

IMPORTANT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO BE FOLLOWED BY THE STUDENTS:

1. Students must show a decent behaviour towards the teacher and staff of the college and also a gentle behaviour to the seniors and fellow students.
2. During college hours students must wear college uniform with Badge and they must carry the Identity Card with them.
3. Students must take proper care of the property of the college and students found involved in destroying college property will be punished.
4. Students should maintain silence in classroom, laboratory, library and academic meetings and functions.
5. Students must maintain discipline in all academic and non-academic activities.
6. Ragging is strictly prohibited inside the college campus and hostel. Students found involved in such activities will be expelled from the college immediately.
7. Prior permission from the authority of the college will be required for organizing functions, picnic, educational excursions or any other entertainment programme.
8. Students must keep their mobile phone in switch off or silent mode.
9. All kinds of toxicants are strictly prohibited inside the college campus.
10. A student having two wheeler must have Driving License. They will not be allowed to enter the college campus without Helmet and relevant documents of their vehicle.

ATTENDANCE:

Regular attendance in class is compulsory for all students. The minimum attendance should be 80% of the classes held in each subject in an academic year. Students below 80% attendance in class will be treated as non-collegiate and they will be eligible to appear in the examination only after payment of a non-collegiate fees. The students with attendance below 60% will be debarred from appearing in the End-Semester Examination and treated as discollegiate.

AWARD TO MERITORIOUS STUDENTS:

1. The “Pranat Chetia Memorial Award” is awarded to the one who secures 1st class with highest mark having Honours in Education. It comprises a cash of Rs. 3000/-, a ‘Certificate of Appreciation’ and a Gamocha. It is instituted by Mrs. Tulumoni Chetia, Head of the Department of Education of the College in memory of her brother.
2. An award is given to a student who secures highest mark having Honours in Assamese. The award is instituted by Mrs. Tulika Changmai, Head of the Department of Assamese of the college.

CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTENSION ACTIVITIES:

The ‘College Week’ is observed every year in the college. Students are encouraged to participate in various cultural activities. The college provides all basic facilities for sports and career development. Many students of Sapekhati College have been able to show their performance in sports and cultural activities.

LIBRARY:



The College has a Central Library with a collection of 5800 books. The library subscribes a quite a good number of journals, reference books, newspapers, quarterly magazines and other magazines also. Moreover, each Department of the College has own Departmental Libraries with a good number of text books and reference books which provides a good opportunity for the students. The College has Internet facility and the Library of automation under SOUL system.

RULES OF THE LIBRARY:

The students of the College should observe the following rules:

1. Library Cards are issued by the Librarian. The students of HS Class are eligible for the number of 1 Card and the students of the Undergraduate Course are eligible for the number of 2 Cards.
2. One book is issued against one card.
3. A student can borrow a book for maximum of 6(six) days.
4. A borrower will be responsible for any damage or loss of books in his/her possession.
5. A student has to pay a fine of Rs. 2/- (rupees two) only per day if he/she fails to return the books on due date.
6. Students should maintain perfect order and silence in the library.
7. The Library Card is not transferable.

HOSTEL FACILITY FOR GIRLS:

Hostel facility is available only for girls. The two storied hostel can accommodate 40 Nos. of boards. The hostel is equipped with toilets, running water facilities with uninterrupted power supply round the clock.

Hostel seats are allotted on the basis of merit and preference will be given to the students residing far away from the college.
